Continue following Route 8 for another 8 miles into Union City. At the first traffic light, turn right onto West High Street. Follow this for two blocks, then turn right onto 2nd Ave. After one block, turn left.

From the South & West: Take your best route to I-79 North and take Exit 166 for Edinboro, PA. Turn right onto US Route 6N, which becomes US Route 6. Follow this until it intersects with PA Route 8 (approximately 19 miles). Turn left onto PA-8. Go through two stop lights, and at the third light turn left onto West High Street. Follow this for two blocks, then turn right onto 2nd Ave. After one block, turn left.

Book Review of the Month by THF Dagonell

The Invisible Hook: The Hidden Economics of Pirates by Peter Leeson

The title is a reference to 'the invisible hand' a phrase by our founding fathers and used in the original <u>Federalist Papers</u> as a reference to how economics drives the country. This is a text explaining how economics drove piracy, creating a workable democracy (each ship was in essence a small corporation, and each crew member a stock holder), workman's compensation (first found aboard Bartholomew 'Black Bart' Roberts ship's articles and how booty was divided fairly to encourage each man to remain a pirate rather than attempt a shore living. It's a fascinating book if you're into that sort of thing.

Recipe of the Month by THF Dagonell

Eggplant Pancakes from Cariadoc's Miscellany

Get sweet eggplant and boil it with water and salt until it becomes well cooked and is dissolved or falling apart. You should drain the water, crush and stir it on a dish with crumbs of grated bread, eggs beaten with oil, dried coriander and cinnamon; beat it until all becomes equal. Afterwards fry cakes made with this batter in a frying pan with oil until they are gilded. Make a sauce of vinegar, oil, almori, and mashed garlic; give all this a shaking and pour it over the top.

1 large eggplant1 1/4 t coriander~2 qts water1 1/2 t cinnamon~2 t salt2 T vinegar1/2 c bread crumbs2 T oil3 eggs2 t murri1 T oil2 large clove garlicabout 6 T oil for frying

Peel and quarter eggplant, boil 30 minutes. Drain, mash and mix with bread crumbs, eggs, oil, coriander and cinnamon. Crush garlic in a garlic press and mix up sauce. Fry in oil at medium high, about 1-2 minutes a side. Pour sauce over pancakes before serving.

The above recipe is from Cariadoc's Miscellany (http://www.pbm.com/~lindahl/cariadoc/islamic_w_veggi es.html#2) I doubled the recipe and entered it in a contest at an Arabian Nights themed event. I had to add another 1/2 cup of bread crumbs and 2 more eggs to get a paste that would hold together to fry.

Murri is an Arabic condiment. Cariadoc gives a recipe for it, but it is very complex and my attempt failed. I made the sauce of vinegar, oil, and garlic. I will make another attempt at Murri.

I received no votes for 'best dish'. On the other hand, almost all of it was eaten. I think this would make an acceptable side dish for a feast, it's cheap, filling and tasty.
