Recipe Redactions by THFool Dagonell the Juggler

I have acquired <u>The Redwall Cookbook</u> by Brian Jacques. It's foods mentioned from the Redwall fantasy series, but since the characters are all mice, moles, rabbits and such, it's actually a nice vegetarian cookbook with recipes that would do well at a medieval feast.

Gourmet Garrison Grilled Leeks

- 4 medium leeks, cleaned, chopped into 1-1/2" lengths
- 2 T unsalted butter, softened
- 1 T grated Parmesan cheese
- 2 t Dijon mustard

Pre-heat the broiler. Bring a pot of water to boil and add salt. Boil the leeks for ten minutes, then drain and transfer to an ovenproof dish. In a separate bowl, cream the butter and add the cheese and mustard. Spread this mixture over the leeks. Broil leeks until golden, about three minutes.

I found this dish quite tasty and would be willing to serve it at feast. The most time-consuming part was washing and chopping the leeks.

Hotroot Sunsalad

Salad:

3 medium parsnips, peeled and cut into coins
3 medium carrots, peeled and cut into coins
6 small Jerusalem artichokes, peeled, cut into coins
1 small leek, thinly sliced
salt to taste

Dressing:

1/4 c wine vinegar 2 T extra-virgin olive oil Dash of hot pepper sauce Pinch of salt

Put a pot of salted water on to boil. Clean, peel, and cut the veggies. This will be the most labor intensive portion of the recipe. Boil the veggies for 10 minutes and drain. While vegetables are boiling, put dressing ingredients in a small bowl and whisk throughly. Pour dressing over veggies, toss and serve hot. Serves 2. Very tasty. I think this would make an excellent side dish at feast.
